I would also like to thank our leaders, Gloria Blackburn, Dr. Gregory Saccone, Elizabeth Oyekan, PharmD, Joan Henry, Dr. Brian Lee, Maxwell Cheng, OD, Janice Trang OD, Daphne Chan, OD and the local Jamaican liaisons, Dr. Ian Titus & Michelle White, who worked tirelessly to support our efforts, without all, the mission would not have been a success. Appreciation goes out to our seminar presenters.

A total of **1,774** medical patients were seen and provided with appropriate medicines. **1,634** eye patients were screened and given eye drops as appropriate, in addition. 1351 reading glasses were dispensed. Seventeen cataract surgeries were performed.

Six basic schools were visited, and 300 students were given school bags with school supplies. The education team interviewed and provided 4 Students from the HEART program with scholarships.

This accomplishment is something to be extremely proud of!

AOJAH will be hosting the annual gala on Saturday, November 4, 2023, at the Universal Sheraton. We are looking forward to you supporting this event, this is our major fundraiser for our annual mission.

St Ann communities get free healthcare, supplies

More than 250 residents in the St Ann South constituency comprising children and adults from the districts of Whitehall, Mosley Hall, Dillon Town and Blackstonedge benefited from free medical care and aid provided by overseas-based charity the Alliance of Jamaican and American Humanitarians (AOJAH) at the St George's Anglican Church and Basic School on Tuesday.



The California, USA-based organisation, which works collaboratively to provide quality healthcare, education programmes and social services to the poor, underprivileged and low to moderate income individuals, was on one of its usual stops in the island.



2023 Medical Mission Report

The Alliance of Jamaican and American Humanitarians (AOJAH) executed their 9th Medical and Education Mission to Jamaica June 11th – 16th, 2023.

AOJAH in collaboration with St. Ann's Bay Hospital and its Health Centers performed Eye services to include cataract surgeries, eye examinations and dispensing of eyeglasses and eye drops; Medical screening in 7 St. Ann's Bay clinics, one clinic in Old Harbor and the Bahia Principe Resort. A seminar was also provided for the medical staff and nurses on June 11th at the St Anns Bay hospital.

The following donations were also made:

- St. Ann's Bay Hospital Donation of equipment and supplies, NICU training and education of staff.
- Port Maria Hospital Cataract surgeries and donation of supplies.
- Spanish Town Hospital Donation of supplies.

We saw a total of 1,634 patients for eye examinations, 1,774 adults and 352 pediatric patients for health screening.

participants, There 90 21 were 2 RNs LVN. 11 physicians, 7 Optometrists, 20 Optometry students, 4 pharmacists, 2 medical students, surgical tech, 1 RN Educator, 2 Therapist and 23 support staff. The increase in physicians really improved the flow of patients.

Thanks to all our volunteers and members who made this trip possible through donations and personal time and commitment. The people of Jamaica were truly grateful for the services provided.

AOAJH education team which consisted of 5 members including 3 teachers visited 6 basic schools, a special program for boys and the HEART College of Hospitality.

During this visit we were able to provide back packs with school supplies to almost 300 students as well as supplies for teachers for each school.

We granted four additional \$500 scholarships to students attending HEART College of Hospitality as well as continued to fund scholarships for two students at Titchfield High School.

2023 FUNDRAISERS


